NOVICE CLASSES: Are for riders 1st year of showing in said discipline. You will not receive points in any other class shown in said novice discipline. (Ex. If you show Novice Walk-Trot English, then show Walk-Trot 12 & Under you only get points in the Novice Walk-Trot English class.)

"BEGINNER" are for riders 12 & under that are new to riding (NOT new to showing) and **MAY NOT** ride in any other riding classes. This rule is put in place to keep all riders safe.

AMATEUR CLASSES: Are open to those who are not paid professionals and are 20 years of age and over.

1. NO YOUTH MAY SHOW A STALLION IN ANY OF THE CLASSES!! NO EXCEPTIONS!! Youth – 19 years & under.
2. NO Alcohol or Profanity while on MSSC property.
3. Pets must be kept on a leash at all times.
4. Proper attire for your discipline should be worn in all the Judged classes. Judge may choose to excuse English Jackets at their discretion.
5. Must be a member of MSSC to receive a Year End Award.
6. **Members must show 3 out of the 6 shows per class to qualify for Year End Awards.**
