Mountain Stream Saddle Club Show Rules and General Information

- No alcohol while on Mountain Steam Saddle Club property.
- No profanity while on Mountain Stream Saddle Club property.
- All pets must be on a leash at all times.
- Exhibitors and spectators will be expected to act in a proper manner, ethical and honest, to conduct themselves in a "good sportsmanlike" manner at all times.
- Mountain Stream Saddle Club reserves the right to ask anyone to leave the property for any violation.
- Negative Coggins required.
- Shows are open, you do not have to be a member to show or compete.
- Mountain Stream Saddle Club membership is from March of current year to March of the following year.
- Must be a member to receive points toward yearend awards. Membership forms and fees are due at the first show you show or compete in before points will be awarded.
- Members must show or compete in 3 out of the 6 shows, per class, to qualify for yearend awards in that class.
- Outstanding indebtedness to Mountain Stream Saddle Club will be cause for loss of placing and points.
- NO Youth (19 & Under) may show a stallion in any of the classes. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- The Judge's decision is final. Verbal confrontation with the Judge or any show official will not be tolerated.
- Beginner Classes are for riders 12 & Under who are new to ridding.
- Riders who ride in Beginner Classes may not ride in any other classes. This is for the rider's safety.
- Novice Classes are open to any age rider who is showing said discipline for the 1st season (Pleasure, English or Running Classes). Novice rider may not show in Novice classes more than 1 year.
- Novice Riders can ride in advanced classes that they rode in as a novice, but will not receive points in the advanced classes. Ex.: The Rider rides in Novice Western Pleasure, rider will receive points for Novice Western Pleasure. Then the Rider rides in Western Pleasure 13-19, rider will not receive points in Western Pleasure 13-19.
- Amateur classes are open to those who are not paid professionals and are over 20 years of age.
- Proper attire for your discipline should be worn in all the judged classes.
- In the English classes, jackets are to be worn unless excused by the judge. If jackets are excused your shirt must have sleeves.
- Runners must wear shoes with a heel and shirts must have a cap sleeve. NO tank tops.
- Penalties or broken patterns can *ONLY* be called by the officials in the Arena.
- Any protest of call made by the officials in the Arena must be discussed with them.
- Mountain Stream Saddle Club officials have the final voice in all matters.
- Shows are based on AQHA rules, when there is not a MSSC rule stated.
- Points for yearend awards go the member exhibitor. Points are awarded to members as follows:

 place = 7 points 2^{nd} place = 6 points 3^{rd} place = 5 points 4^{th} place = 4 points 5^{th} place = 3 points 6^{th} place = 2 points

All other places and No Times will receive 1 point.
